

Program Proposal Guidelines

CAMP empowers creative expression, celebrates interconnection, and promotes healthy living in the Cherokee neighborhood through community projects, classes and artist residency.

Organizations and individuals who wish to create a program or class at CAMP must submit a program proposal to the CAMP Collective. The Proposal should be a 1-2 page document (single spaced) that describes the proposed program including:

- Program Activities
- Target Population (age, income, race, etc.)
- Projected Outcomes (number of students, learning goals, etc)
- Fee Structure (class cost, etc.)
- Days/times/frequency/duration of program
- Budget (optional)

Program proposals must be submitted to CAMP Events Coordinator by the first Tuesday of the month for consideration by CAMP collective. Program representative may attend the Tuesday meeting to represent the proposal to the collective. Please contact Events Coordinator with any further questions regarding the program proposal.
